- 8 guidelines to be developed by the Arkansas Department of Health. However, a
- 9 minimum of \$5,000 per county of said funds shall be utilized to support and
- 10 operate a County Emergency Management Office. These county offices shall be
- 11 prepared to respond to any Arkansas Nuclear I emergency. These funds shall be
- 12 equally distributed to each Emergency Management Office in the following
- 13 counties: Pope County, Johnson County, Yell County, Conway County and Logan

- 15 The funds appropriated for Grants for Nuclear Planning shall be
- 16 distributed in quarterly installments by the Arkansas Department of Health to

- 26 FEES. On July 1 of each year the Arkansas Department of Health shall pay
- 27 \$50,000 from the Operations appropriation provided herein from non-general

- 8 DEVELOPMENT RESTRICTIONS. In reviewing the impact on public health and

- 12 Health shall consider the effect of the plan on future development or zoning
- 13 of adjoining properties.

- 17 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 19 NURSING/DIRECT CARE EDUCATION STIPEND PROGRAM. Special provision for a
- 20 Nursing/Direct Care Education Stipend Program for the Arkansas Department of
- 21 Health (ADH) is hereby authorized to pay from funds appropriated in this Act.
- 22 This program is for eligible nursing students who are attending accredited
- 23 nursing institutions to become Advanced Practice Nurses.

SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD OF FUNDS.

- (a) Except as authorized in subsection (c) of this section, the Department of Health is authorized to carry forward any unspent funds remaining in the Public Health Fund on June 30, 2019 2020 allocated for the support of the Trauma System to be used for the same purposes in the next fiscal year.
- (b) Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:
 - (1) Prior to June 30, 2019 2020, the agency shall by written statement set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the Office of Budget of the Department of Finance and Administration;
- 16 (2) The Office of Budget of the Department of Finance and
 17 Administration shall report to the Legislative Council all amounts carried
 18 forward by the September meeting of the Legislative Council or the Joint
 19 Budget Committee meeting which report shall include the name of the agency,
 20 board, commission, or institution and the amount of funding carried forward,

- 35 WORKS AND ARKANSAS HEALTH INSURANCE MARKETPLACE RESTRICTIONS. (a) As used in
- 36 this section, "Arkansas Works" means the Arkansas Works established under the

1 (ii) Educational materials and information 2 distributed under subdivision (c)(2)(C)(i) of this section shall contain only 3 factual information and shall not contain subjective statements regarding the 4 coverage for which the potential recipient might be eligible; and 5 Using an Internet website for the exclusive purpose of 6 enrolling individuals in the Arkansas Health Insurance Marketplace or 7 Arkansas Works. 8 (d) The Department of Health shall not apply for or accept any funds, 9 including without limitation federal funds, for the purpose of advertisement, 10 promotion, or other activities designed to promote or encourage enrollment in 11 the Arkansas Health Insurance Marketplace or Arkansas Works. 12 (e)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (e)(2) of this section, the 13 Department of Health shall not: 14 (A)(i) Except as provided in subdivision (e)(1)(A)(ii) of 15 this section, allocate, budget, expend, or utilize an appropriation 16 authorized by the General Assembly for the purpose of funding activities of 17 navigators, guides, certified application counselors, and certified licensed 18 producers under the Arkansas Health Insurance Marketplace Navigator, Guide, 19 and Certified Application Counselors Act, Arkansas Code § 23-64-601 et seq. 20 Subdivision (e)(1)(A)(i) of this section does 21 not apply to regulatory and training responsibilities related to navigators, 22 guides, certified application counselors, and certified licensed producers; 23 and 24 (B) Apply for or accept any funds, including without 25 limitation federal funds, for the purpose of funding activities of 26 navigators, guides, certified application counselors, and certified licensed 27 producers under the Arkansas Health Insurance Marketplace Navigator, Guide, 28 and Certified Application Counselors Act, Arkansas Code § 23-64-601 et seq. 29 (2) Subdivision (e)(1) of this section does not apply to 30 certified application counselors at health related institutions, including 31 without limitation the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences. 32 (f) An appropriation authorized by the General Assembly shall not be 33 subject to the provisions allowed through reallocation of resources or 34 transfer of appropriation authority for the purpose of transferring an 35 appropriation to any other appropriation authorized for the Department of

Health to be allocated, budgeted, expended, or utilized in a manner

- l prohibited by this section.
- 2 (g) The provisions of this section are severable, and the invalidity 3 of any subsection or subdivision of this section shall not affect other 4 provisions of the section that can be given effect without the invalid 5 provision.
 - (h) This section expires on June 30, 20192020.

SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 23. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

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
