29	SECTION 1. Arka	ansas Code $ 6-18-227(b)(1)(B) $, conc	erning the time by
30	which an individual ma	ay apply for a transfer under the Ar	kansas Opportunity
31	Public School Choice	Act of 2004, is amended to read as f	ollows:
32	(B) <u>-</u>	(i) Except as provided in subdivisi	on (b)(l)(B)(ii) of

2	(ii)(a) If a student has a parent or guardian who is
3	an active-duty member of the military and who has been transferred to and
4	resides on a military base, then the student's parent or guardian may submit
5	a request for transfer under this section at any time during the calendar
6	<u>year.</u>
7	(b) An application for transfer under
8	subdivision (b)(1)(B)(ii)(a) of this section shall:
9	(1) Be filed with the nonresident school
10	district within fifteen (15) days of the parent's or guardian's arrival on
11	the military base;
12	(2) Include the parent's or guardian's
13	military transfer orders; and
14	(3) Include the parent's or guardian's
15	proof of residency on the military base.

17	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-18-227(b)(2)(A)(ii), concerning the
18	Arkansas Opportunity Public School Choice Act of 2004, is amended to read as
19	follows:
20	(ii) (a) \triangle Except as provided in subdivision
21	(b)(2)(A)(ii)(b) of this section, a transfer under this section is effective
22	at the beginning of the next academic year.
23	(b) A transfer under this section for a
24	student who has a parent or guardian who is an active-duty member of the
25	military and who resides on a military base is effective upon the approval of
26	the accepting school board at its next meeting.
27	
28	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-18-1905(a), concerning an application for
29	a transfer under the Public School Choice Act of 2015, is amended to read as
30	follows:
31	(a) If a student seeks to attend a school in a nonresident district,
32	the student's parent shall submit an application:
33	(1) To the nonresident district, which shall notify the resident
34	district of the filing of the application within ten (10) calendar days of
35	receipt of the application;
36	(2)(A) On a form approved by the Department of Education; and.

1	(B) If a student has a parent or guardian who is an		
2	active-duty member of the military and who has been transferred to and		
3	resides on a military base, then the student's parent or guardian shall file		
4	an application for transfer under this section within fifteen (15) days of		
5	the parent's or guardian's arrival on the military base, which shall include		
6	without limitation the parent's or guardian's:		
7	(i) Military transfer orders; and		
8	(ii) Proof of residency on the military base; and		
9	(3) $\underline{\text{(A)}}$ Postmarked no later than May 1 of the year in which the student		
10	seeks to begin the fall semester at the nonresident district.		
11	(B) However, if a student has a parent or guardian who is		
12	an active-duty member of the military, then the student's application for a		
13	transfer under this section is not subject to the May 1 deadline under		
14	subdivision (a)(3)(A) of this section if the student's parent or legal		
15	guardian:		
16	(i) Has been transferred to and resides on a		
17	military base; and		
18	(ii) Provides military transfer orders that confirm		
19	the date of transfer to the military base.		
20			
21	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-18-1905(e), concerning an application for		
22	a transfer under the Public School Choice Act of 2015, is amended to read as		
23	follows:		
24	(e)(1) By Except as provided in subdivision (e)(4) of this section, by		
25	July l of the school year in which the student seeks to enroll in a		
26	nonresident district under this subchapter, the superintendent of the		
27	nonresident district shall notify the parent and the resident district in		
28	writing as to whether the student's application has been accepted or		
29	rejected.		
30	(2) If the application is rejected, the superintendent of the		
31	nonresident district shall state in the notification letter the reason for		
32	rejection.		
33	(3) If the application is accepted, the superintendent of the		
34	nonresident district shall state in the notification letter a reasonable		
35	deadline by which the student shall enroll in the nonresident district and		
36	after which the acceptance notification is null.		

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(4) The July 1 deadline under subdivision (e)(1) of this section does not apply in the case of an application received from a student who has a parent or guardian who is an active-duty member of the military and who has been transferred to and resides on a military base. /s/Evans
