20	TO AMEND THE DEADLINE BY WHICH A STUDENT
21	WHO HAS A PARENT OR GUARDIAN WHO RESIDES
22	ON A MILITARY BASE MAY APPLY FOR A
23	TRANSFER UNDER THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CHOICE
24	ACT AND THE ARKANSAS OPPORTUNITY PUBLIC
25	SCHOOL CHOICE ACT.
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28	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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30	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code \S 6-18-227(b)(1)(B), concerning the time by
31	which an individual may apply for a transfer under the Arkansas Opportunity
32	Public School Choice Act of 2004, is amended to read as follows:
33	(B)(i) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(l)(B)(ii) of
34	this section, The the parent, guardian, or the student, if the student is
35	over eighteen (18) years of age, has notified the Department of Education and
36	both the sending and receiving school districts of the request for a transfer

1	no later than July 30 of the first year in which the student intends to
2	transfer.
3	(ii)(a) If a student has a parent or guardian who is
4	an active-duty member of the military and who has been transferred to and
5	resides on a military base, then the student's parent or guardian may submit
6	a request for transfer under this section at any time during the calendar
7	year.
8	(b) An application for transfer under
9	subdivision (b)(1)(B)(ii)(a) of this section shall:
10	$\underline{(1)}$ Be filed with the nonresident school
11	district within fifteen (15) days of the parent's or guardian's arrival on
12	the military base;
13	(2) Include the parent's or guardian's
14	military transfer orders; and
15	(3) Include the parent's or guardian's
16	proof of residency on the military base.
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18	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-18-227(b)(2)(A)(ii), concerning the
19	Arkansas Opportunity Public School Choice Act of 2004, is amended to read as
20	follows:
21	(ii) (a) A Except as provided in subdivision
22	(b)(2)(A)(ii)(b) of this section, a transfer under this section is effective
23	at the beginning of the next academic year.
24	(b) A transfer under this section for a
25	student who has a parent or guardian who is an active-duty member of the
26	military and who resides on a military base is effective upon the approval of
27	the accepting school board at its next meeting.
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29	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-18-1905(a), concerning an application for
30	a transfer under the Public School Choice Act of 2015, is amended to read as
31	follows:
32	(a) If a student seeks to attend a school in a nonresident district,
33	the student's parent shall submit an application:
34	(1) To the nonresident district, which shall notify the resident
35	district of the filing of the application within ten (10) calendar days of
36	receipt of the application;

1	(2) $\underline{(A)}$ On a form approved by the Department of Education; and.
2	(B) If a student has a parent or guardian who is an
3	active-duty member of the military and who has been transferred to and
4	resides on a military base, then the student's parent or guardian shall file
5	an application for transfer under this section within fifteen (15) days of
6	the parent's or guardian's arrival on the military base, which shall include
7	without limitation the parent's or guardian's:
8	(i) Military transfer orders; and
9	(ii) Proof of residency on the military base; and
10	(3) $\underline{(A)}$ Postmarked no later than May 1 of the year in which the student
11	seeks to begin the fall semester at the nonresident district.
12	(B) However, if a student has a parent or guardian who is
13	an active-duty member of the military, then the student's application for a
14	transfer under this section is not subject to the May 1 deadline under
15	subdivision (a)(3)(A) of this section if the student's parent or legal
16	guardian:
17	(i) Has been transferred to and resides on a
18	military base; and
19	(ii) Provides military transfer orders that confirm
20	the date of transfer to the military base.
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22	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 6-18-1905(e), concerning an application for
23	a transfer under the Public School Choice Act of 2015, is amended to read as
24	follows:
25	(e)(1) By Except as provided in subdivision (e)(4) of this section, by
26	July 1 of the school year in which the student seeks to enroll in a
27	nonresident district under this subchapter, the superintendent of the
28	nonresident district shall notify the parent and the resident district in
29	writing as to whether the student's application has been accepted or
30	rejected.
31	(2) If the application is rejected, the superintendent of the
32	nonresident district shall state in the notification letter the reason for
33	rejection.
34	(3) If the application is accepted, the superintendent of the
35	nonresident district shall state in the notification letter a reasonable

after which the acceptance notification is null. (4) The July 1 deadline under subdivision (e)(1) of this section does not apply in the case of an application received from a student who has a parent or guardian who is an active-duty member of the military and who has been transferred to and resides on a military base. /s/Evans
