11 ENDING JUNE 30, 2020; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS -
16 PULASKI TECHNICAL COLLEGE APPROPRIATION
17 FOR THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR.

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the University of Arkansas - Pulaski Technical College for the 2019-2020
24 fiscal year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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 14 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 15 the University of Arkansas - Pulaski Technical College for the 2019-2020
 16 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 17 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 18 herein for such purposes: four hundred (400) temporary or part-time
 19 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the
 20 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act
 21 for the appropriate classification.

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 23 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
 24 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas - Pulaski Technical College, to
 25 be payable from the University of Arkansas - Pulaski Technical College Fund,
 26 for personal services of the University of Arkansas - Pulaski Technical
 27 College for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, the following:

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 33 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - CASH FUNDS. There is hereby appropriated,
 34 to the University of Arkansas - Pulaski Technical College, to be payable from
 35 cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the University of Arkansas
 36 - Pulaski Technical College, for personal services and operating expenses of

21 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 22 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 23 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 24 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
 27 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 28 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 29 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 30 with in disbursement of said funds.

32 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 33 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 34 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 35 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 36 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

1 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
2 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
3 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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5 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
6 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
7 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
8 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
9 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
10 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
11 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm
12 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
13 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
14 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
15 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.
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
