20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-8-215(c)(1), concerning the forfeiture
23 of retirement benefits by judges or justices who become seventy (70) years of
24 age during a term of office to which they are elected, is amended to read as
25 follows:

26 (c)(1) ~~Any A judge or justice who becomes seventy (70) years of age~~
27 ~~during a term of office to which he or she has been elected~~ is not seventy
28 (70) years of age on the date on which he or she is elected to a term of
29 office may complete the term without forfeiting his or her rights to
30 retirement benefits under this section.
