20	(1) Only dispense eyeglasses after performing a refraction if		
21	the patient's visual acuity is correctable to 20/20; and		
22	(2) Advise the patient that a refraction is not a complete eye		
23	examination and that the patient should visit a licensed optometrist or		
24	licensed physician skilled in disease of the eye for a complete evaluation		
25	and follow-up care.
