- 17 <u>17-1-108</u>. Endorsement, recognition, and reciprocity of licenses,
- 18 <u>registrations</u>, or certifications.
- 19 (a)(1) It is the intent of the General Assembly to ensure that a
- 20 person may be credentialed to work in Arkansas if he or she generally
- 21 <u>demonstrates the skills and ethics required by state law based on the</u>
- 22 person's experience and credentials in another state.
- 23 (2) It is not the intent of the General Assembly to cause the
- 24 licensing entity to engage in simple comparisons of the required hours of
- 25 <u>training and other personal qualifications under Arkansas's occupational</u>
- 26 <u>licensing statutes with those qualifications required in the state where the</u>
- 27 person is credentialed.
- 28 (b)(1) As used in this section "licensing entity" means an agency,
- 29 board, commission, department, committee, or other authority of the
- 30 government of the State of Arkansas, whether within or subject to review by
- 31 another agency, that has the duty to license, register, certify, or otherwise
- 32 approve a person to work in a particular field or industry.
- 33 (2) As used in subdivision (g)(1) of this section "agency" does
- 34 not include the General Assembly, the courts, or the Governor.
- 35 (c) A licensing entity shall by rule adopt the least restrictive
- 36 requirements for licensing, registration, or certification for a person who:

1	(1) Demonstrates that he or she:

9	(D) Is not holding a suspended or probationary license in

11	(E) Is sufficiently competent in his or her field; and
12	(2) Pays any licensing, registration, or certification fee
13	required by law.
14	(d)(l)(A) A licensing entity shall comply with the requirements under
15	subsection (b) of this section by adopting a rule that is least restrictive
16	that allows for state-to-state reciprocity.
17	(B) The rule under subdivision (d)(1)(A) of this section
18	shall provide the procedure by which a licensing entity shall grant a one-
19	year temporary reciprocal license or permit to a person under subsection (b)
20	of this section by presenting evidence of current and active licensure,
21	registration, or certification in another state.
22	(2) If a state does not require licensing, registration, or
23	certification for a profession that requires licensing, registration, or
24	certification in this state, a licensing entity shall adopt a rule that is
25	least restrictive to permit a person to obtain licensing, registration, or
26	certification for that profession in this state.
27	(3) The licensing entity may require additional state-specific
28	education for persons certified or licensed in other states that do not offer
29	reciprocity similar to reciprocity under this section to persons licensed or
30	certified in this state.
31	(e)(1) Except as provided under subdivision (e)(2) of this section, a
32	licensing entity shall not require a person who meets the requirements of
33	subsection (b) of this section to participate in the apprenticeship,
34	education, or training required as a prerequisite to licensing, registration,
35	or certification of a new professional in the field.
36	(2) The licensing entity may require the person to participate

1	in continuing education or training if the continuing education or training		
2	is required for all professionals in the field to maintain the license,		
3	registration, or certification.		
4	(f) If a criminal background check is required of an applicant for an		
5	original license, registration, or certification, or of a person currently		
6	holding a license, registration, or certification, then the licensing entity		
7	may require a person seeking reinstatement under this section to meet the		
8	same criminal background check requirements as the applicant for an original		
9	license, registration, or certification, or as the person currently holding a		
10	license, registration, or certification.		
11	(g) The licensing entity may require the person or entity applying for		
12	licensure, registration, or certification under this section to meet any		
13	bonding, financial statement, or insurance requirements that are applicable		
14	to all applicants.		
15	(h) This section shall not apply to:

17	17-26-315, 17-27-308, 17-28-306, 17-31-308, 17-36-304, 17-43-307, 17-83-305,

19	17-99-304, 17-100-304, and 17-103-302; or		
20	(2) The licensing entities that administer the reciprocity or		
21	endorsement provisions under subdivision (h)(l) of this section.		
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
