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26	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-61-907 is amended to read as follows:	
27	23-61-907. Data release.	
28	(a) Data in the Arkansas Healthcare Transparency Initiative shall:	
29	(1) To the extent authorized by the State Insurance Department	· ,
30	be available:	
31	(A) When disclosed in a form and manner that ensures the	<u>;</u>
32	privacy and security of protected health information as required by state a	ınd
33	federal laws, as a resource to insurers, employers, purchasers of health	
34	care, researchers, state agencies, and healthcare providers to allow for	
35	assessment of healthcare utilization, expenditures, and performance in this	;

2	(B) To state programs regarding healthcare quality and
3	costs for use in improving health care in the state, subject to rules
4	prescribed by the department State Insurance Department conforming to state
5	and federal privacy laws or limiting access to limited-use data sets; and
6	(2) Not be used to:
7	(A) Disclose trade secrets of submitting entities;
8	(B)(i) Reidentify or attempt to reidentify an individual
9	who is the subject of any submitted data without obtaining the individual's
10	consent.
11	(ii) Subdivision (a)(2)(B)(i) of this section does
12	not apply to the State Insurance Department or the Department of Human
13	Services; or
14	(C) Create or augment data contained in a national claims
15	database.
16	(b) (1) Notwithstanding Except as provided in subdivision (b)(2) of
17	this section and notwithstanding the Health Insurance Portability and
18	Accountability Act of 1996, Pub. L. No. 104-191, or any other provision of
19	law, the Arkansas Healthcare Transparency Initiative shall not publicly
20	disclose any data that contains direct personal identifiers.
21	(2) The Arkansas Healthcare Transparency Initiative may disclose
22	claims data that contains direct personal identifiers of eligible individual
23	in the Arkansas Works Program to the State Insurance Department and the
24	Department of Human Services.
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26	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 23-61-1004(g), concerning the
27	administration of the Arkansas Works Program, is amended to read as follows:
28	(g)(1) On a quarterly basis, the Department of Human Services, the
29	State Insurance Department, the Department of Workforce Services, and other
30	necessary state agencies shall report to the Legislative Council, or to the
31	Joint Budget Committee if the General Assembly is in session, available
32	information regarding the overall Arkansas Works Program, including without
33	limitation:
34	(A) Eligibility and enrollment;
35	(B) Utilization;
36	(C) Premium and cost-sharing reduction costs;

1	(D) Health insurer participation and competition;
2	(E) Avoided uncompensated care; and
3	(F) Participation in job training and job search programs.
4	(2)(A) A health insurer who that is providing an individual
5	qualified health insurance plan or employer health insurance coverage <u>under</u>
6	this subchapter for an eligible individual shall submit quarterly claims and
7	enrollment data to the State Insurance Department and the Department of Human
8	Services to facilitate reporting required under this subchapter or other
9	state or federally required reporting or evaluation activities.
10	(B) A When submitting claims and enrollment data to the
11	State Insurance Department, a health insurer may utilize existing mechanisms
12	with supplemental enrollment information to fulfill requirements under this
13	subchapter, including without limitation the state's all-payer claims
14	database established under the Arkansas Healthcare Transparency Initiative
15	Act of 2015, § 23-61-901 et seq., for claims and enrollment data submission.
16	(C) When submitting claims and enrollment data to the
17	Department of Human Services, a health insurer shall submit the information
18	electronically in a format determined by the Department of Human Services.
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
