12	other than a registered lobbyist shall result in a written warning.		
13	(B) Upon a second violation and subsequent violations by		
14	persons other than registered lobbyists and upon a first violation by		
15	registered lobbyists, the penalties provided for in § 7-6-218 shall apply.		
16	(c) As used in this section, "contractor" means a person or entity
