- 2 (5) Beginning July 1, 2014, if the reciprocal system in which a
- 3 member has service credit has fewer than the number of years of service
- 4 credit required in the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System's formula for the
- 5 calculation of final average salary for a member, then the Arkansas Teacher
- 6 Retirement System shall obtain the salary and service eredit information from
- 7 the reciprocal system and use the combined salary and service credit
- 8 information to calculate the member's final average salary as if the salary
- 9 and service credit have all been earned in the Arkansas Teacher Retirement
- 10 System.
- 11 (6) When the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System provides a
- 12 benefit amount that is not dependent on length of credited service, the
- 13 benefit amount shall be reduced to the proportion that actual system service
- 14 bears to total reciprocal system-credited service.

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- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-7-701(d) and (e), concerning voluntary
- 17 retirement under the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, is repealed.
- 18 (d) A member retiring with an effective date other than July 1 or the
- 19 first day of a calendar quarter within the fiscal year may receive service
- 20 eredit for the current year and use the salary for the current year in the
- 21 calculation of the member's final average salary with the following
- 22 restrictions: If a member has accrued a full year of service credit for a
- 23 fiscal year, the annuity shall not begin earlier than on the July 1 after the
- 24 fiscal year.
- 25 (1) Credited service for service within the fiscal year shall
- 26 not exceed one-quarter (1/2) year for each full calendar quarter elapsed since
- 27 the beginning of the fiscal year; and
- 28 (2) Service credit to be used in the computation of benefits
- 29 shall be computed only on the full calendar quarter completed and shall not
- 30 include service credit for a partial calendar quarter worked.
- 31 (e)(1) If a member has signed an employment contract for a fiscal
- 32 school year and been paid in full for that fiscal school year, in no event
- 33 shall the annuity begin earlier than the July 1 next following that fiscal
- 34 school year.
- 35 (2) If a member has signed an employment contract for a fiscal
- 36 school year and if that contract is not completed, the member shall receive

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4	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
5	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the		
6	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act which created the Arkansas Teacher		
7	Retirement System as a state agency for the purpose of providing retirement		
8	benefits to school employees in Arkansas, are in need of revision and		
9	updating to maintain the teacher retirement laws in conformance with sound		
10	public pension policy; that the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System operates		
11	on a fiscal year of July 1 to June 30; that having a July 1, 2019 effective		
12	date is necessary to allow the provisions of this act to take effect on the		
13	first day of the fiscal year in order to facilitate the proper administration		
14	of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System; that revisions and updates to the		
15	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act are of great importance for actuarial		
16	purposes and to protect member benefits; and that this act is necessary to		
17	maintain an orderly system of managing member benefits offered by the		
18	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to		
19	exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace,		
20	health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2019.		
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
