1 fiscal year, the annuity shall not begin earlier than on the July 1 after the 2 fiscal year. 3 (1) Credited service for service within the fiscal year shall 4 not exceed one quarter (1/2) year for each full calendar quarter elapsed since 5 the beginning of the fiscal year; and 6 (2) Service credit to be used in the computation of benefits shall be computed only on the full calendar quarter completed and shall not 7 8 include service credit for a partial calendar quarter worked. 9 (e)(1) If a member has signed an employment contract for a fiscal 10 school year and been paid in full for that fiscal school year, in no event 11 shall the annuity begin earlier than the July 1 next following that fiscal 12 school year. 13 (2) If a member has signed an employment contract for a fiscal 14 school year and if that contract is not completed, the member shall receive eredit for service within the current fiscal year as provided in this 15 16 section. 17 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 18 19 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act, which created the Arkansas Teacher 20 Retirement System as a state agency for the purpose of providing retirement 21 22 benefits to school employees in Arkansas, are in need of revision and 23 updating to maintain the teacher retirement laws in conformance with sound public pension policy; that the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System operates 24 25 on a fiscal year of July 1 to June 30; that having a July 1, 2019 effective 26 date is necessary to allow the provisions of this act to take effect on the 27 first day of the fiscal year in order to facilitate the proper administration of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System; that revisions and updates to the 28 29 Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act are of great importance for actuarial 30 purposes and to protect member benefits; and that this act is necessary to maintain an orderly system of managing member benefits offered by the 31 32 Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to 33 exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, 34 health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2019. 35
