24 25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-115-404 is amended to read as follows: 23-115-404. Confidential information.
26	(a)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (a)(2) and subsections (b)
27	and (c) of this section, the Office of the Arkansas Lottery shall comply with
28	the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.
29	(2) The following records or information shall be treated as
30	confidential and are exempt from public disclosure under the Freedom of
31	Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.:
32	(A) Information pertaining to the security of lottery
33	games and lottery operations, including without limitation:
34	(i) Security measures, systems, or procedures; and
35	(ii) Security reports; and
36	(B) Any records exempt from disclosure under the Freedom

1	of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.; and
2	(C)(i) Any identifying records or information regarding a
3	lottery winner who wins over five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) only if
4	the lottery winner requests that his or her identifying records and
5	information remain confidential and exempt from disclosure under the Freedom
6	of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq.
7	(ii) The office shall notify a lottery winner who
8	wins over five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) of the option to remain
9	confidential under subdivision (a)(2)(C)(i) of this section.
10	(iii) The exemption for a lottery winner who wins
11	over five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) under subdivision (a)(2)(C)(i)
12	of this section does not apply to an elected public official.
13	(iv) The office may make public the location at
14	which a lottery winner under subdivision (a)(2)(C)(i) of this section
15	purchased the winning lottery ticket.
16	(b) Except as otherwise required by law, an employee of the office
17	or of an entity listed in subsection (c) of this section who has been given
18	access to any identifying records or information regarding a lottery winner
19	who wins over five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) shall not disclose the
20	identifying records or information of the lottery winner who wins over five
21	hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to another individual or entity.
22	(b)(c) The following entities Arkansas Legislative Audit shall have
23	full access to the records of the office $ au$:
24	(1) The Internal Revenue Service;
25	(2) Arkansas Legislative Audit;
26	(3) The Department of Finance and Administration;
27	(4) The Federal Bureau of Investigation; and
28	(5) The Department of Arkansas State Police.
29	(d) The office shall require one of its employees to serve as a
30	custodian who shall monitor lottery winners to ensure that a person who has
31	won the lottery on multiple occasions does not have information that
32	influences or increases the person's chance of winning the lottery.
