## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING THE DATES FOR THE BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL YEAR; TO AMEND THE DATE ON WHICH PUBLIC SCHOOLS SHALL BEGIN THE SCHOOL YEAR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle<br>TO AMEND THE DATE ON WHICH PUBLIC SCHOOLS SHALL BEGIN THE SCHOOL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-10-106(a), concerning the dates for the beginning and end of the school year is amended to read as follows:
(a)(l)(A) In each school year, the first day of the school year for student attendance in the public elementary and secondary schools of the State of Arkansas shall not be:
(i) On or after the Monday of the week in which

## August 19 falls;

(ii) Not earlier than August 14; and the Monday before Labor Day
(iii) Not later than August 26 .
(B) The date for beginning the school year shall be determined by the board of directors of the each school district in accordance with subdivision (a)(1)(A) of this section.
(C) Labor Day shall be celebrated as a school holiday in all the school districts of the state, and school shall not be held on that date.
(D) (C) As used in this section, "week" means a seven-day period that begins on a Sunday and ends on a Saturday.
(2) The Department of Education may grant a school district a waiver to begin school on an earlier of a later date if the department determines that there exists a material and substantial reason for the school district to begin school on an earlier of a later date due to very exceptional or emergency circumstances such as a contagious disease outbreak, inclement weather, or other acts of God.
