20	(iii) Whether the venue is indoors or outside; and
21	(iv) Any other factor relevant to determining the
22	appropriate security regulations for the different types of events and
23	locations throughout the state.
24	(2) The protocol specifications shall include without
25	limitation:
26	(A) Designation of the types and sizes of items that may
27	be brought into an event;
28	(B) Standards for purses, bags, sacks, backpacks, and
29	other implements designed to carry other items; and
30	(C) Standards and recommendations for secure admissions to
31	public events.
32	(g)(l) The committee shall report its findings and recommendations to
33	the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management on or before December 31,
34	<u>2019.</u>
35	(2)(A) The department shall notify the arenas, stadiums,
36	auditoriums, and other facilities represented by the members of the committee

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1	by publication of the findings and recommendations of the committee on its
2	website.
3	(B) Upon request to the department, the findings and
4	recommendations of the committee will be made available to any public entity
5	for use at a ticketed or unticketed event.
