23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-31-302(5), concerning the qualifications
26	to register as a forester, is amended to read as follows:
27	(5) A two-year associate's degree in forestry from a community
28	college or junior college and, subsequent to graduation, six (6) years' or
29	more \overline{of} experience in forestry work of a nature satisfactory to the board.
30	
31	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-31-304(c), concerning the examinations
32	required by the Arkansas State Board of Registration for Foresters, is
33	amended to read as follows:
34	(c) A candidate who fails an examination may apply for another
35	examination at the expiration of six (6) months from the date of failure of
36	the prior examination.
