20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §§ $6-18-1202-6-18-1204$ are amended to read

22	6-18-1202. Written policy.	
23	Each school district board of directors shall adopt rules and	
24	regulations in the form of a written student publications media policy	
25	developed in conjunction with the student $\frac{\text{publication}}{\text{publication}}$ advisors and the	
26	appropriate school administrators, consistent with the other provisions of	
27	this subchapter, which shall include reasonable provisions for the time,	
28	place, and manner of distributing student publications school-sponsored	
29	media.

31	6-18-1203. Students' right of expression.	
32	(a) Student <u>media</u> policies shall recognize that students may exercise	
33	their right of expression within the framework outlined in § 6-18-1202

15	Student publications policies shall recognize that truth, fairness,
16	accuracy, and responsibility are essential to the practice of journalism, and

18	journalists are not authorized:
19	(1) $\frac{Publications}{Student}$ $\frac{Student}{Student}$ that are obscene as to minors, as

21	(2) Publications <u>Student media</u> that are libelous or slanderous,
22	as defined by state law;
23	(3) Publications Student media that constitute an unwarranted
24	invasion of privacy, as defined by state law; or and
25	(4) Publications $Student media$ that so incite students as to

27	(A) A clear and present danger of the commission of
28	unlawful acts on school premises;
29	(B) The violation of lawful school regulations; or
30	(C) The material and substantial disruption of the orderly

33	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 18, Subchapter 12, is
34	amended to add additional sections to read as follows:
35	6-18-1205. Definitions.
36	As used in this subchapter:

1	(1)(A) "Student media" means any means of communication that
2	are:
3	(i) Prepared, substantially written, published, or
4	broadcasted by a student;
5	(ii) Distributed or generally made available, either
6	free of charge or for a fee, to members of the student body; and
7	(iii) Prepared under the direction of a student
8	media advisor.
9	(B) "Student media" does not include media that is
10	intended for distribution or transmission solely in the classroom in which it
11	is produced;
12	(2) "Student journalist" means a student who gathers, writes,
13	edits, photographs, records, video tapes, or prepares information for
14	dissemination in student media; and
15	(3) "Student media advisor" means an individual who is employed,
16	appointed, or designated by a public school district to supervise or provide
17	instruction with respect to student media.
