27	SECTION 1. Ark	ansas Code § 15-4-2003(13), conce	rning the definitions	
28	used under the Digital Product and Motion Picture Industry Development Act of			
29	2009, is amended to r	ead as follows:		
30	(13) "St	ate-certified production" means a	qualified production	
31	produced by an eligib	le production company that is:		
32	(A)	In compliance with established	rules to this	
33	subchapter;			
34	(B)	Authorized by the Film Office to	o conduct business in	
35	this state; and			
36	(C)	Approved by the Film Office $\underline{\text{Exe}}$	cutive Director of the	

1 <u>Arkansas Economic Development Commission</u> as qualifying for a <u>discretionary</u> 2 production rebate under this subchapter.

- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2005(a), concerning production rebates under the Digital Product and Motion Picture Industry Development Act of 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a)(1) A The Executive Director of the Arkansas Economic Development
 8 Commission may offer to a production company, upon approval of the
 9 application by the Arkansas Economic Development Commission, shall be
 10 eligible for that has submitted an application under § 15-4-2007 a rebate of
 11 up to twenty percent (20%), with no cap per production, on all qualified
 12 production costs in connection with the production of a state-certified film
 13 project.
 - (2) An If the executive director approves a project for a rebate under this section, an additional rebate of ten percent (10%) shall be granted for the payroll of below-the-line employees who are full-time residents of Arkansas.

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2006(a), concerning postproduction rebates under the Digital Product and Motion Picture Industry Development Act of 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- (a)(1) A The Executive Director of the Arkansas Economic Development

 Commission may offer to a qualifying production company, upon approval of the application by the Arkansas Economic Development Commission, shall be eligible for that has submitted an application under § 15-4-2007 a rebate of up to twenty percent (20%), with no cap per production, on all qualified production costs in connection with the postproduction of a state-certified film project.
- (2) An If the executive director approves a project for a rebate under this section, an additional rebate of ten percent (10%) shall be granted for the payroll of below-the-line employees who are full-time residents of Arkansas.

SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2007(a) and (b), concerning an application for a rebate under the Digital Product and Motion Picture Industry Development Act of 2009, are amended to read as follows:

1	(a)(1) To quarriy apply for the repates provided under this		
2	subchapter, a production company shall submit an application and provide an		
3	estimate of total expenditures to be made in Arkansas in connection with the		
4	production.		
5	(2) The application and estimate of expenditures required under		
6	subdivision (a)(1) of this section shall be filed with the Arkansas Economic		
7	Development Commission and be approved by the Executive Director of the		
8	Arkansas Economic Development Commission as eligible for the rebate provided		
9	by this subchapter before the commencement of production in Arkansas.		
10	(b)(1) After each production company submits an application, the		
11	commission If an application for a rebate is approved under subsection (a) o		
12	this section, the production company and the executive director shall sign a		
13	financial incentive agreement with each eligible production company that		
14	qualifies under this subchapter and is approved by the commission.		
15	(2)(A) The financial incentive agreement shall define the		
16	benefits incentives to be received and the start and end date of the project		
17	(B) The financial incentive agreement shall include the:		
18	(i) Effective date of the financial incentive		
19	agreement;		
20	(ii) Term of the financial incentive agreement,		
21	which shall be calculated from the date the agreement is signed by the		
22	production company and the Executive Director of the Arkansas Economic		
23	Development Commission executive director;		
24	(iii) Incentive for which the production company may		
25	qualify;		
26	(iv) Investment threshold requirements necessary to		
27	qualify for eligibility;		
28	(v) Production company's responsibilities for		
29	certifying eligibility requirements; and		
30	(vi) Production company's responsibilities for		
31	failure to meet or maintain eligibility requirements.

33	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2007(e)(1) and (2), concerning an		
34	application for a rebate under the Digital Product and Motion Picture		
35	Industry Development Act of 2009, are amended to read as follows:		
36	(e)(1) Production companies are encouraged to make payments for		

- production and post-production postproduction expenses from a checking account from an Arkansas financial institution.
- 3 (2) Direct cash payments by a production company to Arkansas vendors, businesses, or citizens hired as cast or crew that are accompanied by receipts shall may be allowed if the sum of the cash payments does not exceed forty percent (40%) of the total verifiable expenditures.

- 8 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2007(h)-(l), concerning an application 9 for a rebate under the Digital Product and Motion Picture Industry 10 Development Act of 2009, are amended to read as follows:
- 11 (h)(1) The If approved by the executive director, the employment
 12 rebate also entitles a state-certified production for to an additional rebate
 13 for employing full-time residents of Arkansas.
 - (2) The employment rebate authorizes an additional credit of ten percent (10%) for the aggregate payroll of salaries and wages to Arkansas residents who are below-the-line employees of the state-certified production.

- (i) The If approved by the executive director, the employment rebate shall may include the first five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) of a highly compensated individual's salary.
- (j) Payments for penalties or fines, payments to nonprofit organizations, and payments to federal and state entities that do not pay state taxes are not eligible.
- (k) If a production company hires a payroll service company to handle the payroll of a production, the payroll payments otherwise allowable shall may be allowed as eligible expenditures if all eligible income payments to employees and independent contractors done through the payroll service are subject to Arkansas state income taxes.
- 29 (1)(1)(A) Within two (2) weeks after principal photography begins, the 30 production company shall begin filing weekly expenditure reports.
- 31 (B) Failure to file weekly expenditure reports may result 32 in a delay in the disbursement of the rebate provided in §§ 15-4-2005 and 15-33 4-2006.
- 34 (2) The weekly expenditure report shall be filed in accordance 35 with but shall not be limited to the following:
- 36 (A) Direct cash payments by the production company to

19	(3) The production company shall provide documentation for		
20	expenditures in accordance with rules promulgated by the Film Office		
21	commission.

23	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2008(a), concerning the disbursement		
24	of rebate incentives under the Digital Product and Motion Picture Industry		
25	Development Act of 2009, is amended to read as follows:		
26	(a) The Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and		
27	Administration shall upon receipt of an application for a rebate, including		
28	proof of performance expenditure report from the Film Office:		
29	(1) Calculate the total expenditures of the relevant production		
30	company for which there are documented receipts for funds expended in the		
31	state;		
32	(2) Calculate the incentive benefit to which the applicant is		
33	entitled, subject to any conditions of the approved financial incentive		
34	agreement; and		
35	(3) Provide certification to the Director of the Department of		

Finance and Administration specifying the amount to be remitted to the

I	production company within one hundred twenty (120) days after the final
2	expenditure report has been submitted.

4	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2008(c)(1), concerning the
5	disbursement of rebate incentives under the Digital Product and Motion
6	Picture Industry Development Act of 2009, is amended to read as follows:
7	(c)(1) There is no per-production cap on the rebate, and the amount of
8	the rebate shall be limited only by the amount of moneys in the Digital
9	Product and Motion Picture Office Fund. The amount of the rebate is limited
10	to the amount specified in the approved financial incentive agreement.
11	
12	SECTION 10. Arkansas Code § 15-4-2011 is amended to read as follows:
13	15-4-2011. Sunset.
14	The opportunity for a rebate provided by this subchapter shall expire
15	on June 30, 2019 <u>2029</u> .
