- (i) The If approved by the executive director, the employment rebate shall may include the first five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) of a highly compensated individual's salary.
- (j) Payments for penalties or fines, payments to nonprofit organizations, and payments to federal and state entities that do not pay state taxes are not eligible.
- (k) If a production company hires a payroll service company to handle the payroll of a production, the payroll payments otherwise allowable shall may be allowed as eligible expenditures if all eligible income payments to employees and independent contractors done through the payroll service are subject to Arkansas state income taxes.
- 30 (1)(1)(A) Within two (2) weeks after principal photography begins, the 31 production company shall begin filing weekly expenditure reports.

9	the rebate shall be limited only by the amount of moneys in the Digital
10	Product and Motion Picture Office Fund. The amount of the rebate is limited
11	to the amount specified in the approved financial incentive agreement.
