(2) If the private school intends to enroll students with disabilities who have an individualized education program in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq., or an individualized service plan in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1412(a)(10), the notice shall specify the grade levels and services that the private school has available for students with severe disabilities who are participating in the Succeed Scholarship Program. SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 6-41-903(d)(2), concerning the administering of nationally recognized norm-referenced tests to Succeed Scholarship Program students by an eligible private school, is amended to read as follows: (2) A student with an individual education plan or an individualized service plan that provides for an exemption to standardized testing is not required to take the test required under subdivision (d)(l) of this section.
