19 20	SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - BOONEVILLE HUMAN DEVELOPMENT CENTER.

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33	SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - DIRECTOR'S OFFICE. There is hereby	
34	appropriated, to the Department of Human Services - Director's Office,	to be
35	payable from the Development and Enhancement Fund, for the Department	of
36	Human Services - Director's Office the following:	

1 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided 2 in Item (A) of Section 2 of Act 13 of 2018, for various maintenance, 3 renovation, equipping, construction, acquisition, improvement, upgrade, and 4 repair of real property and facilities department-wide, in a sum not to exceed\$10,000,000. 5 6 7 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION - ADDITIONAL MEDICAID FUNDING - GRANT There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human Services 8 9 - Division of Medical Services, to be payable from the Development and 10 Enhancement Fund, for the Department of Human Services - Division of Medical 11 Services the following: 12 (A) Effective July 1, 2019, the balance of the appropriation provided in Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 13 of 2018, for grant payments of the 13 14 Arkansas Medicaid Program of the Department of Human Services - Division of 15 Medical Services - Grants, in a sum not to exceed\$56,000,000. 16 17 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 18 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 19 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 20 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 21 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 22 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 23 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 24 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 25 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 26 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 27 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 28 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act. 29 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State 30 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the 31 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of 32 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and 33 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in 34 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided

35 36 otherwise by law.

I	SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General	
2	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations	
3	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for	
4	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive	
5	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget	
6	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or	
7	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative	
8	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.	
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10	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General	
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the	
12	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the	
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of	
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in	
15	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the	
16	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm	
17	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental	
18	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act	
19	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health	
20	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019.	
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
