12	this election according to law and to the best of my abilities, and that I		
13	will studiously endeavor to prevent fraud, deceit, and abuse, and that I will		
14	not disclose how any voter shall have voted, unless required to do so as a		
15	witness in a judicial proceeding or a proceeding to contest an election."		
16	(d) (1) Each student selected to be an election official shall:

19	$\frac{(B)}{(2)}$ Serve under the supervision of the appropriate		
20	county board of election commissioners;		
21	$\frac{(G)}{(3)}$ Observe strict impartiality at all times; and		
22	$\frac{(D)}{(4)}$ Be granted an additional excused absence from		
23	school while working as an election official.		
24	(2) A high school student selected to be an election official		
25	may be compensated according to § 7-4-112 if the county board of election		
26	commissioners determines that the high school students selected to be		
27	election officials should be compensated.
