(B) First alternate members of the Legislative Council 29 30 shall have a vote in matters before the Legislative Council if the regular member which the first alternate represents is not in attendance. 31 32 (C) First alternate members attending as nonvoting members 33 of the Legislative Council shall receive per diem and mileage to be paid in 34 the same manner and from the same source as regular members of the Legislative Council. 35 36 (3) Second alternate members of the Legislative Council shall

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1 have a vote in matters before the Legislative Council if the regular member 2 and the first alternate member which the second alternate represents are not 3 in attendance. 4 (c) In the event of a tie vote in the congressional caucus to elect 5 members and alternates, the member or alternate shall be elected by the 6 entire membership of the House or Senate, as the case may be. 7 (d)(1) Following the selection by caucus of the regular and alternate 8 Senate members of the Legislative Council from the respective congressional 9 districts, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint from the 10 membership of the Senate his or her first and second alternate members. 11 (2) The designation of first and second alternate members by the 12 President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall be made prior to adjournment of 13 each regular session of the General Assembly. 14 (3)(A) The selection and designation of first and second 15 alternate members from the membership of the House shall be in accordance 16 with the procedure prescribed by the Rules of the House of Representatives. 17 (B) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the 18 contrary, after January 1, 1999, the selection and designation of first and 19 second alternate members from the membership of the Senate shall be in 20 accordance with the procedure prescribed by the Rules of the Senate. 21 (4) The names of the persons shall be entered upon the journal 22 of the respective houses. 23 (e)(1) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary, tenure of membership and the means of filling vacant positions for Senate 24 Legislative Council members shall be as prescribed by the Rules of the 25 26 Senate. 27 (2) Tenure of membership and means of filling vacant positions 28 for House Legislative Council members shall be as prescribed by the Rules of 29 the House of Representatives. 30 (f)(l) The cochairs of the Joint Budget Committee shall be ex officio voting members of the Legislative Council. 31 32 (2) The House Chair of the Joint Budget Committee may designate 33 the House Vice Chair of the Joint Budget Committee and other House chairs of Joint Budget Committee subcommittees as ex officio nonvoting members of the 34 Legislative Council, thereby authorizing their attendance at meetings of the 35 36 Legislative Council and its subcommittees.

22	Council shall require approval by a separate vote of Senate Legislative		
23	Council members and House Legislative Council members.
