23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 12, Subchapter 4, is amended	to

26	(a) As used in this section:	_
27	(1) "Law enforcement agency" means a police force or	
28	organization whose primary responsibility as established by statute or	
29	ordinance is the enforcement of the criminal laws, traffic laws, or highway	ay_
30	laws of this state;	
31	(2) "Medical-legal examination" means health care delivered	to a
32	possible victim of a sex crime, with an emphasis on the gathering and	
33	preserving of evidence for the purpose of prosecution;	
34	(3) "Sexual assault collection kit" means a human biological	·
35	specimen or specimens collected during a medical-legal examination from t	<u>he</u>
36	alleged victim of a sex crime;	

1	(4) "Sex crime" means an offense described in § 5-14-101 et seq.
2	or § 5-26-202; and
3	(5) "Untested sexual assault collection kit" means a sexual
4	assault collection kit that has been submitted to the State Crime Laboratory
5	for either a serology or DNA test but that has not yet been tested.
6	(b) A law enforcement agency shall not retain possession of a sexual
7	assault collection kit for more than ten (10) days before submitting the
8	sexual assault collection kit to the State Crime Laboratory for testing.
9	(c) The laboratory shall complete the testing or analysis of an
10	untested sexual assault collection kit submitted under this section within
11	forty-five (45) days after the date of receipt of the untested sexual assault
12	collection kit.
