framed copy; and (c) Be displayed in a large font size; (B) An accurate representation of the United States flag, which shall be centered under the national motto; and (C) An accurate representation of the Arkansas state flag or flags. (2) The materials in durable posters or framed copies donated or purchased under subdivision (a)(1) of this section may shall be displayed in each: (A) Public institution of higher education and elementary and secondary school library and classroom in this state; and (B) Public building or facility in this state that is maintained or operated by state funds. (b) The copies or posters authorized under this section shall either be donated or shall be purchased solely with funds made available through voluntary contributions to the local school boards, local building governing entity, or the Building Authority Division of the Department of Finance and Administration.
