1	(2) A municipal firefighter shall be disciplined only for		
2	violation of policies reasonably related to the orderly, safe, and efficient		
3	operation of the municipal fire department.		
4	(c) Discipline within a municipal fire department shall be applied in a		
5	fair and consistent manner and only after a fair and objective investigation		
6	that demonstrates substantial proof or evidence that the municipal firefighter		
7	was guilty of violating a policy.		
8	(d) The discipline to which a municipal firefighter is subjected		
9	shall:		
10	(1) Reflect the seriousness of the offense and the municipal		
11	firefighter's record of past service; and		
12	(2) Be consistent with the municipal fire department's previous		
13	application of discipline for similar offenses.		
14	(e)(l) A municipal firefighter shall be notified and present at the		
15	commencement of any search of his or her personal property unless the		
16	municipal firefighter waives the right or the search is executed under a		
17	lawful search warrant.		
18	(2) As used in this subsection, "personal property" includes		
19	without limitation the municipal firefighter's personal vehicle, locker, or		
20	other personal effects not issued by the municipal fire department.		
21	(f) For purposes of promotion or assignment, a municipal firefighter is		
22	not required to disclose any item of his or her property, income, assets,		
23	debts, or expenditures, or those of any member of the municipal firefighter's		
24	household.		
25	(g) Except when on duty or acting in his or her official capacity, a		
26	municipal firefighter is not prohibited from engaging in political activity		
27	or from refusing to engage in political activity.		
28	(h) A municipal fire department shall not limit the freedom of		
29	personal choice in a municipal firefighter's family matters, including without		
30	limitation off-duty employment, personal relationships, domicile, or		
31	religious observances.		
32	(i) A municipal fire department shall not limit the size of an		
33	applicant pool for positions within the municipal fire department.		
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
