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(b)(1) A public school <u>or school</u> district that elects to offer an academic study of the Bible course shall implement the course in accordance with the Arkansas Constitution and the United States Constitution, including the manner in which the course is taught in the classroom and the assignment of public school or school district personnel teaching the course.

6 (2) Personnel assigned to teach the course shall be licensed to 7 teach in the State of Arkansas.

8 (3) Personnel shall not be assigned to teach the course based on9 any:

10 11 (A) Religious test;

(B) Profession of faith or lack of faith;

12 (C) Prior or present religious affiliation or lack of13 affiliation; or

14 (D) Criteria involving particular beliefs or lack of15 beliefs about the Bible.

16 (c) An academic study of the Bible course offered by a public school 17 <u>or school</u> district shall:

18 (1) Be taught in an objective and nondevotional manner with no
19 attempt made to indoctrinate students as to either the truth or falsity of
20 the biblical materials or texts from other religious or cultural traditions;
21 (2) Not include teaching of religious doctrine or sectarian

22 interpretation of the Bible or of texts from other religious or cultural 23 traditions; and

24 (3) Not disparage or encourage a commitment to a set of 25 religious beliefs.

26 (d) A public school <u>or school</u> district that elects to offer an

(2) Teach an academic study of the Bible course.
