24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-7-608 is amended to read as follows:
27	20-7-608. Information exchange with other prescription drug monitoring
28	programs.
29	(a) The Department of Health may provide prescription monitoring
30	information to federal prescription drug monitoring programs or other states
31	prescription drug monitoring programs, and the information may be used by
32	those programs consistent with this subchapter.
33	(b) The department may request and receive prescription monitoring
34	information from federal prescription drug monitoring programs or other
35	states' prescription drug monitoring programs and may use the information
36	under this subchapter.

(c) The department may develop the capability to transmit information
to other prescription drug monitoring programs and receive information from $% \left( 1\right) =\left( 1\right) \left( 1\right$
other prescription drug monitoring programs employing the standards of
exchangeability.

(d) The department may enter into written agreements with <u>federal</u> <u>prescription drug monitoring programs or</u> other states' prescription drug monitoring programs for the purpose of describing the terms and conditions for sharing prescription information under this subchapter.
