3	(a) There is created a focus group to develop, by May 1, 2020, a

6	county clerk to serve as notification that the active or retired law			
7	enforcement officer requires his or her real property records, personal			
8	property records, or tax records to be private.			
9	(b) The members of the focus group shall be appointed by the Speaker			
10	of the House of Representatives, and membership shall consist of:			
11	(1) One (1) circuit court county clerk in this state;			
12	(2) One (1) county assessor in this state;			
13	(3) One (1) county tax recorder in this state;			
14	(4) One (1) representative of the banking industry in this			
15	state;			
16	(5) One (1) representative from a title company in this state;			
17	and			
18	(6) One (1) active law enforcement officer in this state.			
19	(c)(1) The focus group shall meet at least three (3) times before May			
20	<u>1, 2020.</u>			
21	(2) The focus group shall meet at least one (1) time during each			
22	of the months of August, December, and April.
