Application of certification requirements. 18 (a) A person who has practiced natural hair braiding for two (2) 19 consecutive years as of December 31, 2015, shall be granted a natural hair 20 braiding certificate if he or she completes and files the following on or 21 before December 31, 2015: 22 (1) An application for certification; 23 (2) Payment of the registration fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) 24 every two (2) years; 25 (3) An affidavit signed by the applicant attesting that he or 26 she has practiced hair braiding for two (2) consecutive years; and 27 (4) An affidavit signed by an employer or customer of the 28 applicant attesting that he or she has witnessed the applicant practicing 29 natural hair braiding in the past two (2) years. 30 (b)(1) Except as provided under subsection (a) of this section, an applicant for natural hair braiding certification asserting reciprocity with 31 32 another state shall: 33 (A) Provide a certificate, a license, or a registration 34 from another state that shows that he or she was legally practicing natural hair styling, braiding, or natural hair cultivation in that state; 35 36 (B) Pass a written examination approved by the Cosmetology
