27	(c)(1)(A) All o	f the general revenues and the speci	ial revenues shall
28	be distributed within	ten (10) days after the close of each	ch calendar month to
29	the respective cities	of the first and class, cities of the	ne second class, and

31	<u>(B)(</u>	i) General revenues shall be distri	ibuted on the basis
32	of <u>residential</u> populat	ion, which shall be determined according	rding to the most
33	recent federal decenni	al or special census.	
34		(2)(ii) The amount of general rev	venues to be
35	apportioned to each su	eh city or incorporated town is to b	oe in the proportion
36	that each residential population bears to the total residential population of		

1	all such cities and incorporated towns.		
2	(2)(A) Special revenues shall be distributed on the basis of		
3	daytime population, which shall be calculated by:		
4	(i) Adding the residential population of the city or		
5	incorporated town and the total number of persons working in the city or		
6	incorporated town; and		
7	(ii) Subtracting the total number of persons who		
8	both live in the city or incorporated town and work in the city or		
9	incorporated town.		
10	(B) The total number of persons who work in a city or		
11	incorporated town and the total number of persons who live in an incorporated		
12	city or town shall be determined using the Census Transportation Planning		
13	Products of the United States Department of Transportation.		
14	(C) The amount of special revenues to be apportioned to		
15	each city or incorporated town is to be in the proportion that each daytime		
16	population bears to the total daytime population of all cities and		
17	incorporated towns.		
18	(3) In the event of an annexation, the $\underline{residential}$ population of		
19	the annexed area, as certified by the United States Bureau of the Census $\frac{1}{2}$		
20	the Department of Commerce, the number of persons working in the annexed		
21	area, and the number of persons who both reside and work in the annexed area		
22	may be added to the <del>most recent federal decennial or special census</del>		
23	residential population and the daytime population of the annexing		
24	municipality.

26	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 19-5-601(e), concerning the Municipal Aid		
27	Fund, is amended to read as follows:		
28	(e) In the event that the United States Bureau of the Census <del>of the</del>		
29	Department of Commerce determines that the <u>residential</u> population <u>or the</u>		
30	daytime population for a municipality is more than was originally certified		
31	or determined in the decennial census or any part of the residential		
32	population or the daytime population for a municipality was incorrectly		
33	assigned to another municipality and a census count correction or a		
34	correction to the designated municipality is received from the United States		
35	Bureau of the Census by the appropriate officials of the state, the Treasurer		
36	of State shall determine the amount of general and special revenue that the

municipality should have received based upon the corrected census count. Such

     amounts are to be submitted to the Arkansas State Claims Commission for

     inclusion in the appropriation bill requested from the General Assembly for

     approved claims.
