10 ARKANSAS; TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION TO THE DEFINITION
11 OF "EMPLOYEE"; TO AMEND THE MINIMUM WAGE ACT OF THE
12 STATE OF ARKANSAS RESULTING FROM INITIATED ACT 5 OF
13 2018; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 TO AMEND THE MINIMUM WAGE ACT OF THE
17 STATE OF ARKANSAS; TO PROVIDE AN
18 EXCEPTION TO THE DEFINITION OF
19 "EMPLOYEE"; AND TO AMEND THE MINIMUM WAGE
20 ACT OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS RESULTING
21 FROM INITIATED ACT 5 OF 2018.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-4-203(3), concerning the definition of
28 "employee" within the Minimum Wage Act of the State of Arkansas and as
29 affected by Initiated Act 5 of 2018, is amended to add an additional
30 subdivision to read as follows:

31 (S) An individual who is under twenty-one (21) years of
32 age who is enrolled as a full-time student in high school or in an
33 institution of higher education as defined in § 11-10-220(a);

35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 11-4-210(b), concerning the minimum wage
36 for certain full-time students and as affected by Initiated Act 5 of 2018, is



1 repealed.

2 ~~(b) With respect to any full-time student attending any accredited~~
3 ~~institution of education within this state and who is employed to work an~~
4 ~~amount not to exceed twenty (20) hours during weeks that school is in session~~
5 ~~or forty (40) hours during weeks when school is not in session, the rate of~~
6 ~~wage shall be equal to but not less than eighty-five percent (85%) of the~~
7 ~~minimum wage provided in this section.~~

9 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act is effective on and after January
10 1, 2020.
