13	TO AMEND THE LAWS CONCERNING TEACHING

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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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19	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. Legislative findings and intent.	
20	(a) The General Assembly finds that:	
21	(1) Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals, also known as "DACA",	<u>,</u>
22	is a national immigration policy that allows some individuals who are brought	<u>t</u>
23	to the United States illegally as children to receive a renewable two-year	
24	period of deferred action from deportation and to become eligible for a work	
25	permit;	
26	(2) In order to be eligible under the Deferred Action for	
27	Childhood Arrivals policy, a recipient cannot have a criminal record of	
28	felonies or serious misdemeanors;	
29	(3) Several states allow recipients of the Deferred Action for	
30	Childhood Arrivals policy to receive occupational or professional licensure;	
31	(4) Arkansas has chosen not to allow recipients of the Deferred	
32	Action for Childhood Arrivals policy to receive occupational or professional	
33	licensure, which has caused many students who are exempt under the Deferred	
34	Action for Childhood Arrivals policy to leave the state after completion of	
35	their vocational or professional coursework;	
36	(5) Arkaneae is presently suffering from a shortage of teachers	

1	in various parts of the state, particularly teachers who reflect the
2	background and experiences of their students; and
3	(6) It is in the best interest of Arkansas to make full use of
4	the skills and talents in the state by ensuring that an individual who is
5	work-authorized under the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals policy is
6	able to obtain an occupational or professional license and practice his or
7	her occupation or profession.
8	(b) It is the intent of this act to authorize recipients of the
9	Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals policy to receive a teaching license
10	in Arkansas.
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12	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 4, is amended
13	to add an additional section to read as follows:
14	6-17-430. Licensing of noncitizens.
15	(a) The Department of Education may grant a license under this
16	subchapter to an individual who, in addition to fulfilling the requirements
17	to teach in this state, satisfies the following requirements:
18	(1) The United States Department of Homeland Security has
19	approved the individual's request for exemption under the Deferred Action for
20	Childhood Arrivals policy;
21	(2) The individual's exemption status under the Deferred Action
22	for Childhood Arrivals policy has not expired or has been properly renewed;
23	<u>and</u>
24	(3) The individual has a current and valid employment
25	authorization document issued by the United States Citizenship and
26	Immigration Service.
27	(b) This section is a state law within the meaning of subsection (d)
28	of 8 U.S.C. § 1621, as existing on January 1, 2019.
29	(c)(1) The department shall promulgate rules under this section.
30	(2)(A) When adopting the initial rules to implement this
31	section, the final rule shall be filed with the Secretary of State for
32	adoption under § 25-15-204(f):
33	(i) On or before January 1, 2020; or
34	(ii) If approval under § 10-3-309 has not occurred
35	by January 1, 2020, as soon as practicable after approval under § 10-3-309.
36	(B) The department shall file the proposed rule with the

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Legislative Council under § 10-3-309(c) sufficiently in advance of January 1,
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     2020, so that the Legislative Council may consider the rule for approval
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     before January 1, 2020.
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
