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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 21, Chapter 4, Subchapter 1, is amended
21	to add an additional section to read as follows:
22	21-4-107. Paid leave for firefighters with occupationally caused
23 24	<u>cancer.</u> (a)(1) A paid firstighton for the state on any political subdivision
24 25	(a)(1) A paid firefighter for the state or any political subdivision of the state who has completed five (5) or more years of employment as a paid
26	of the state who has completed five (5) or more years of employment as a paid firefighter shall be granted a minimum of one thousand four hundred fifty-six
20	(1,456) hours of paid leave upon the initiation of treatment for an
28	occupationally caused cancer.
29	(2) Paid leave for occupationally caused cancer under
30	subdivision (a)(1) of this section:
31	(A) Does not reduce the accrued sick leave or annual
32	vacation leave of the firefighter;
33	(B) Does not impact any other employment benefit of the
34	firefighter; and
35	(C) May be transferred from a catastrophic leave bank of a
36	fire department that provides a catastrophic leave program if the



1	catastrophic leave program meets the requirements of this subdivision (a)(2).
2	(3) A firefighter is considered to have an occupationally caused
3	cancer if the firefighter:
4	(A) While in the official line of duty, was exposed to a
5	known carcinogen as determined by the Department of Health in consideration
6	with the findings of the International Agency for Research on Cancer; and
7	(B) Has a disability or an impairment of health as a
8	result of a diagnosis of a cancer listed in § 21-5-705(a)(3)(A)(i).
9	(4) A firefighter is not entitled to paid leave under
10	subdivision (a)(1) of this section if the firefighter's cancer:
11	(A)(i) Did not result from the firefighter's employment
12	with the state or political subdivision of the state.
13	(ii)(a) An occupationally caused cancer under this
14	section is presumed to result from a firefighter's employment if at the time
15	of employment the firefighter underwent a physical examination that did not
16	reveal substantial evidence that the occupationally caused cancer existed
17	before his or her employment as a firefighter.
18	(b) To rebut the presumption under subdivision
19	(a)(4)(A)(ii)(a) of this section, the employer shall prove by a preponderance
20	of the medical evidence that the occupationally caused cancer did not occur
21	as a result of employment in the official line of duty; or
22	(B) Did result from the firefighter's employment with the
23	state or political subdivision of the state, but workers' compensation is
24	provided for the occupationally caused cancer.
25	(b)(1) A fire department may participate in a firefighter cancer
26	relief network created and governed by the Arkansas Association of Fire
27	Chiefs, the Arkansas Professional Fire Fighters Association, and the Arkansas
28	State Firefighters Association, Inc.
29	(2) A fire department that participates in a network under
30	subdivision (b)(1) of this section may provide a firefighter to a requesting
31	fire department to relieve a firefighter granted leave under this section and
32	employed by the requesting fire department, if:
33	(A) The fire department that provided the firefighter
34	continues to pay the firefighter's regular rate of pay and benefits,
35	including without limitation any overtime compensation;

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1	continues to be covered by all applicable laws; and
2	(C) The fire department that requested the firefighter
3	provides evidence to the fire department that provided the firefighter of
4	substantial adverse budgetary impact without relief as the result of granting
5	paid leave under this section.
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
