8 AN ACT TO MODIFY LABELING OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS; TO
9 REQUIRE PHYSICIANS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL COUNSELING
10 WHEN PRESCRIBING MEDICATIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

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14 TO MODIFY LABELING OF PRESCRIPTION DRUGS;
15 AND TO REQUIRE PHYSICIANS TO PROVIDE
16 ADDITIONAL COUNSELING WHEN PRESCRIBING
17 MEDICATIONS.

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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-92-411 is amended to read as follows:
23 17-92-411. Prescription contents and labels.

24 (a)(1) Labels on original packages shall bear the label of the
25 distributor or manufacturer, with the proper medicinal dose, if a remedy is
26 used internally.

27 (2) In the case of poisons, the word "POISON" shall be displayed
28 ~~thereon~~ on the label in a conspicuous manner with the antidote for a
29 poisonous dose.

30 (b)(1) A ~~doctor of medicine~~ physician or other person authorized to
31 issue prescriptions, ~~upon the request of the patient,~~ shall indicate briefly
32 and concisely on the prescriptions the conditions for which the medication is
33 prescribed.

34 (2) Every pharmacist filling any ~~such~~ prescription shall include
35 on the label of the prescription container the labeling as stated on the
36 prescription issued.



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 2 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 17-92-505(a)(1), concerning labeling of
 3 generic drugs, is amended to read as follows:

4 (a)(1) The pharmacist filling a prescription for dispensing to an
 5 ultimate patient may affix to the container a label showing:

6 (A) The pharmacy name, address, and telephone number;

7 (B) The date of dispensing;

8 (C) The serial number of the prescription;

9 (D) The name of the patient;

10 (E) The name of the prescribing practitioner;

11 (F) The trade name of the medication, if any, or the
 12 generic name and identity of the manufacturer of the dispensed medication, if
 13 the medication appears generically listed on the drug formulary list as
 14 established by this subchapter;

15 (G) The strength per unit dose of the medication;

16 (H) The quantity of the medication; ~~and~~

17 (I) Directions for use; and

18 (J) The condition for which the drug is prescribed.

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 20 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 95, Subchapter 1, is
 21 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

22 17-95-109. Counsel of prescriptions.

23 When prescribing a medication to a patient, a physician shall provide
 24 counseling to the patient concerning:

25 (1) The medication prescribed; and

26 (2) The medical condition for which the prescription has been
 27 prescribed.
