30	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

32	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-82-311(c), concerning student			
33	requirements for maintaining eligibility under the Arkansas Governor's			
34	Scholars Program, is amended to read as follows:			
35	(c) Provided sufficient funds are available, a scholarship shall be			
36	awarded for one (1) academic year and renewed annually for three (3)			

1 additional academic years if the following conditions for renewal are met: 2 (1) The A student receiving a scholarship under § 6-82-312(a) 3 maintains not less than a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scholastic grading 4 scale; 5 (2) A student receiving a scholarship under § 6-82-312(a) 6-82-6 312(b) maintains not less than a 3.25 grade point average on a 4.0 scholastic 7 grading scale; 8 (3) The A recipient of a scholarship under § 6-82-312(a) and (b) 9 has successfully completed a total of at least twenty-seven (27) hours during 10 the first full academic year and, if applicable, a total of at least thirty 11 (30) hours per academic year thereafter; and 12 (4) The A recipient of a scholarship under § 6-82-312(a) and (b) 13 has met any other continuing eligibility criteria established by the 14 Department of Higher Education -; and 15 (5)(A) If a student who has continuously been a recipient of the 16 scholarship under § 6-82-312(a) or (b) for at least three (3) consecutive 17 years is enrolled as a part-time student in the student's fourth academic 18 year, the student shall be eligible to continue to receive the scholarship 19 under § 6-82-312(a) or (b) if the student has completed, by his or her fourth 20 academic year, or is enrolled in, for his or her fourth academic year, the requisite number of credit hours to complete the student's degree program. 21 22 (B) The scholarship amount for each semester in which a 23 student who is the recipient of a scholarship under § 6-82-312(a) or (b) is 24 enrolled under this subsection shall be prorated by the number of credit 25 hours in which the student is enrolled. 26 27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code  $\S$  6-85-212(e)(1)(A)(iv)(c)(1), concerning the 28 scholarship award amount under the Arkansas Academic Challenge Scholarship 29 Program - Part 2 for a full-time scholarship recipient enrolled in a four-30 year approved institution of higher education, is amended to read as follows: 31 (c)(l) A recipient who is eligible to receive 32 the scholarship under subdivision (e)(1)(A)(iv)(a) of this section may 33 receive the scholarship while enrolled in a semester as a part-time student 34 if the recipient is enrolled in the number of credit hours necessary to 35 complete the recipient's degree program.
