31	SECTION 2. Ark	ansas Code Title 15, Chapter 42, Subch	apter l, is
32	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

34	<u>(a) The Arkans</u>	sas State Game and Fish Commission may	allow a resident
35	who applies for a lic	cense to hunt or fish through the commi	ssion's online
36	sales system to indic	cate a desire to make an anatomical gif	t on his or her

2	(b) If the commission authorizes an anatomical gift option through its		
3	online sales system, the online sales system shall contain statements		
4	sufficient to comply with the Revised Arkansas Anatomical Gift Act, § 20-17-		
5	1201 et seq., so that execution of the application makes the anatomical gift		
6	effective for a resident indicating a desire to make an anatomical gift.		
7	(c) The commission may:		
8	(1) Provide a link on its website to a federally designated		
9	organ procurement organization website that contains information describing:		
10	(A) Arkansas laws regarding anatomical gifts;		
11	(B) The need for and benefits of anatomical gifts; and		
12	(C) The legal implications of making an anatomical gift,		
13	including the law governing revocation of anatomical gifts;		
14	(2) Provide education to Arkansas residents who hunt and fish by		
15	distributing information regarding anatomical gifts and how to register to		
16	<u>make an anatomical gift;</u>		
17	(3) Distribute information regarding an anatomical gift through		
18	print and digital communications targeting Arkansas residents who hunt and		
19	fish; and		
20	(4) Prepare the information regarding an anatomical gift in		
21	conjunction with an organ procurement organization created, organized, and		
22	existing under the laws of the state.		
23	(d)(1) If the commission authorizes an anatomical gift option through		
24	the commission's online sales system, the commission is not required to keep		
25	the physical record of the donor's application after issuing the license in		
26	order for the anatomical gift indication to be valid.		
27	(2)(A) However, the commission shall provide information		
28	required under § 20-17-618 for an individual who has indicated consent on an		
29	online sales system transaction to share private data for the record of		
30	registered donors.		
31	(B) The information submitted under subdivision (d)(2)(A)		
32	of this section is classified as private information and is required to be		
33	shared only as provided in § 20-17-618.
