AN ACT TO PROHIBIT A MINOR FROM PURCHASING A PREPAID MOBILE DEVICE; TO ESTABLISH THE PREPAID MOBILE DEVICE PROTECTION ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PROHIBIT A MINOR FROM PURCHASING A PREPAID MOBILE DEVICE; AND TO ESTABLISH THE PREPAID MOBILE DEVICE PROTECTION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 4 is amended to add an additional chapter to read as follows:

CHAPTER 118
PREPAID MOBILE DEVICE PROTECTION ACT

4-118-101. Title.
This chapter shall be known and may be cited as the "Prepaid Mobile Device Protection Act".

4-118-102. Definitions.
As used in this chapter:
(1) "Minor" means an individual under eighteen (18) years of
age;
(2) "Mobile device user" means a person that buys a mobile device or similar wireless communication device or a set allotment of wireless communication services through refilling of wireless communication
services for a prepaid mobile device;
(3) (A) "Person" means an individual, retailer, corporation,
limited liability company, firm, company, association, or other entity.
(B) "Person" includes:
(i) An authorized reseller that is authorized by a
manufacturer to sell the manufacturer's mobile device; and
(ii) A wireless carrier that is authorized to sell a
prepaid mobile device through which the wireless carrier will provide
wireless communication services.
(C) "Person" does not include a parent, including without limitation a biological parent, adoptive parent, stepparent, legal guardian, or other legal custodian of a minor;
(4) "Prepaid mobile device" means a cellular telephone or other communication device for which the mobile device user purchases a set allotment of wireless communication services;
(5) "Purchaser" means a person that for a prepaid mobile device has paid compensation, traded, or transferred another item of value;
(6) "Sell" means to sell, trade, deliver, or transfer a prepaid mobile device to a person for compensation or another item of value;
(7) "Wireless carrier" means a provider of wireless communication services; and
(8) "Wireless communication services" means any mobile service that is provided for profit and makes interconnected service available to the public.

4-118-103. Sale of prepaid mobile device - Prohibition - Verification required.
(a) A person shall not:
(1) Purchase a prepaid mobile device for a minor in this state;
(2) Sell a prepaid mobile device to a minor in this state; or
(3) Refill a prepaid mobile device with wireless communication services on a previously purchased prepaid mobile device for a minor in this state.
(b) Before a person sells a prepaid mobile device to a mobile device user, the person shall verify that the purchaser is not a minor by requiring the purchaser to display a driver's license or other personal identification
card issued by the federal government or a state government that provides the date of birth of the purchaser.

4-118-104. Penalty.
A person that violates this chapter or who knowingly purchases a
prepaid mobile device or wireless communication services for a minor or knowingly sells a prepaid mobile device or wireless communication services to a minor shall be guilty of a violation and fined no less than one hundred dollars (\$100).
