17	(2) The contractor may be awarded or maintain a contract with a		
18	state agency.

20	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 11, Subchapter 10, is		
21	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:		
22	19-11-1015. Cancellation of contract on entry of final business		
23	closure order.		
24	(a) As used in this subchapter, "final business closure order" means a		
25	business closure order for which a contractor has either:		
26	(1) Waived further administrative review under § 26-18-1001 et		
27	seq.; or		
28	(2) Exhausted all remedies to appeal under § 26-18-1001 et seq.		
29	(b) The Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and		
30	Administration shall provide to the Office of State Procurement all final		
31	business closure orders entered into against a contractor.		
32	(c) Upon receipt of a final business closure order, the Office of		
33	State Procurement shall, as soon as reasonably practicable:		
34	(1) Notify each state agency with which the contractor has a		
35	contract that the:		
36	(A) Contractor is subject to a final business closure		

1	order; and		
2	(B) Provision of any goods or services, or both, under a		
3	contract with the contractor that is subject to a final business closure		
4	order shall cease as soon as reasonably practicable; and		
5	(2) Notify all state agencies that the contractor that is		
6	subject to a final business closure order shall not be awarded or maintain a		
7	contract with a state agency unless the Office of State Procurement provide		
8	notice under subsection (d) of this section.		
9	(d) Upon receipt of information that a contractor has resolved a		
10	business closure, the Office of State Procurement shall notify all state		
11	agencies, as soon as reasonably practicable, that:		
12	(1) Any unexpired contracts with the contractor may continue if		
13	the contract was not terminated, cancelled, suspended, or discontinued; and		
14	(2) The contractor may be awarded or maintain a contract with a		
15	state agency.		
16			
17	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 26-18-303(b), concerning exemptions from		
18	the confidentiality requirement for tax records, is amended to add an		
19	additional subdivision to read as follows:		
20	(26) Disclosure of information related to a business closure		
21	order under § 26-18-1001 et seq. to the Office of State Procurement for the		
22	purpose of carrying out §§ 19-11-273 and 19-11-1015.

24	SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. Sections 1-3 of this act are effective on		
25	<u>January 1, 2020.</u>
