4	annually a report of its activities to the Governor Director of the

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7	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 16-90-715 is amended to read as follows:
8	16-90-715. Action by state against convicted person for recovery of
9	reparations.
10	(a)(1) Whenever any person is convicted of a crime and an order for
11	the payment of reparations is or has been made under this subchapter for a
12	personal injury or death resulting from the act or omission constituting the
13	crime for which conviction was had, the Attorney General Director of the
14	Department of Finance and Administration may institute a civil action against
15	the convicted person for the recovery of all or any part of the reparations
16	paid.
17	(2)(A) The suit shall be instituted in the circuit court having
18	jurisdiction in the county in which the person resides or is found or in
19	Pulaski County.
20	(B) The circuit court shall have jurisdiction to hear,
21	determine, and render judgment in the action.
22	(3)(A) Any amount recovered under this subsection shall be
23	credited to the Crime Victims Reparations Revolving Fund.
24	(B) If an amount greater than that paid pursuant to the
25	order for payment of reparations is recovered and collected in the action,
26	the Crime Victims Reparations Board shall pay the balance to the claimant.
27	(b) The board shall provide the Attorney General director with such
28	information, data, and reports as he or she may require to institute actions
29	in accordance with this section.
30	(c) The director may request the assistance of the Attorney General in
31	instituting a civil action against the convicted person for the recovery of
32	all or any part of the reparations paid.
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
