22	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL
23	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
24	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

26	THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
27	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
28	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
29	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
30	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
31	the State of Arkansas, to wit:

33	SECTION 1. Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 73, § 2, is amended to
34	read as follows:
35	§ 2. Legislative Branch.
36	(a) The Arkansas House of Representatives shall consist of members to

1	be chosen every second year by the qualified electors of the several
2	counties.
3	(b) The Arkansas Senate shall consist of members to be chosen every
4	four <u>(4)</u> years by the qualified electors of the several districts.
5	(c)(l) A member of the General Assembly:
6	(A) Shall not serve more than twelve (12) years as a
7	member of the House of Representatives, whether consecutive or
8	nonconsecutive;
9	(B) Shall not serve more than twelve (12) years as a
10	member of the Senate, whether consecutive or nonconsecutive; and
11	(C) shall in no event serve no more than sixteen (16)
12	years as a member of the General Assembly, whether consecutive or
13	nonconsecutive.
14	(2) A member who completes his or her <u>twelfth</u>
15	year of service as a member of the House of Representatives or Senate or
16	sixteenth year of service <u>as a member of the General Assembly</u> during a term
17	of office for which he or she has been elected may serve until the completion
18	of that term of office.
19	(3) The years of service in both the Senate and the House of
20	Representatives shall be added together and included to determine the total
21	number of years in office.
22	(4) A partial legislative term served as a result of a special
23	election under Article 5, § 6, or a two-year term served as a result of
24	apportionment of the Senate shall not be included in calculating the total
25	number of years served by a member of the General Assembly.

27	SECTION 2. BALLOT TITLE AND POPULAR NAME. When this proposed
28	amendment is submitted to the electors of this state on the general election
29	<pre>ballot:</pre>
30	(1) The title of this Joint Resolution shall be the ballot
31	title; and
32	(2) The popular name shall be "A Constitutional Amendment to
33	Provide that a Person Shall Not Serve More Than Twelve (12) Years as a Member
34	of the House of Representatives and Not More Than Twelve (12) Years as a
35	Member of the Senate, but Shall In No Event Serve More Than Sixteen (16)
36	Years as a Member of the General Assembly".
