20	WHEREAS, Jim House, former representative from Fayetteville, Arkansas,
21	died in a farming accident on December 5, 2018, at 70 years of age; and
22	
23	WHEREAS, Mr. House called Washington County home since 1957, received a
24	bachelor's degree in animal science from the University of Arkansas at
25	Fayetteville, and served in the United States Army as a sergeant and Pershing
26	missile specialist at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, during the Vietnam War era; and
27	
28	WHEREAS, Mr. House was also a farmer and an accomplished farrier, a
29	specialist in shoeing horses; and
30	
31	WHEREAS, Mr. House first ran for office after retiring from a 26-year
32	career with the Department of Health, but his first love was the outdoors;
33	and
34	WHEREAS, during his campaign run, he was often seen campaigning on
35	horseback throughout the district and took time off before the election to
36	hike through the Grand Canyon; and

2	WHEREAS, Mr. House was elected to the House of Representatives in 2006
3	and served until 2010, and during his tenure was known for his watchfulness
4	of our state parks and the environment, as well as his early and vocal
5	support for improved emergency services, including 911 call centers, a
6	statewide trauma care system, and a satellite campus for the University of
7	Arkansas for Medical Sciences; and
8	
9	WHEREAS, Senator Greg Leding said the loss of Mr. House was "a shocking
10	and heartbreaking loss" for the community; and
11	
12	WHEREAS, Senator Uvalde Lindsey said, "He was a true man of the people.
13	That was what he was all about. Friends, family, service to his community:
14	whatever they needed, he was always there",
15	
16	NOW THEREFORE,
17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-SECOND GENERAL
18	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20	THAT the House of Representatives remember and commend Mr. Jim House
21	for his hard work, dedication, and many contributions to the State of
22	Arkansas and his local community.
