15	WHEREAS, cardiovascular disease kills 1 in 3 women in the United
16	States, yet up to 80 percent of cardiovascular disease can be prevented;

19	WHEREAS, cardiovascular disease and stroke kill 1 woman every 80
20	seconds in the United States; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, an estimated 44 million women in the United States are
23	affected by cardiovascular disease; and
24	WHEREAS, 90% of women have 1 or more risk factors for developing
<ul><li>25</li><li>26</li></ul>	cardiovascular disease or stroke, yet only 1 in 5 women believe
27	cardiovascular disease is among their greatest health threats; and
28	cardiovascular disease is among their greatest hearth threats, and
29	WHEREAS, women are less likely to call 911 for themselves when
30	experiencing symptoms of a heart attack than they are if someone else is
31	having a heart attack; and

33	WHEREAS, only 36% of African-American women and 34% of Hispanic women
34	know that heart disease is their greatest health risk, compared with 65% of
35	Caucasian women; and

1	WHEREAS, the American Heart Association's Go Red For Women movement
2	encourages women to learn their family histories and to meet with healthcare
3	providers to determine their risks for cardiovascular disease and stroke;

6	WHEREAS, women involved with the Go Red For Women movement live
7	healthier lives; and

9	WHEREAS, the Go Red For Women movement encourages women to take
10	control of their heart health by knowing and managing their total
11	cholesterol, HDL cholesterol, blood pressure, blood sugar, and body mass
12	index; and

14	WHEREAS, the American Heart Association observes the entire month of
15	February each year as American Heart Month to raise awareness of the
16	importance of the ongoing fight against cardiovascular disease and stroke,
