14 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER OF FUNDS FOR LOCAL JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITIES. The Chief Fiscal Officer 16 17 of the State shall transfer funds in an amount of \$400,000 for the fiscal 18 year ending June 30, 2019 2020 from the Department of Human Services - Youth 19 Services Fund Account to the Juvenile Detention Facilities Operating Fund to 20 fund the appropriation to the Department of Finance and Administration -21 Disbursing Officer for grants for operating expenses of local juvenile 22 detention facilities.

The 34 Division of Youth Services is authorized to use the administrative operating 35 account for capital improvements to the physical plant and for the purchase 36 of capital equipment by the Mansfield Youth Services Facility operated by the

1 Department of Human Services, Division of Youth Services. The funds shall be 2 held by the Department of Human Services, Division of Youth Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be harvested from land owned by the 3 4 Division of Youth Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be 5 tracked separately. The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to 6 provide funds to finance capital improvements to the physical plant and for 7 the purchase of major capital equipment by the Mansfield Facility from which 8 the timber is sold.

9 The Division of Youth Services shall report all income derived from the 10 sale of timber to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas 11 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Any contracts initiated for 12 the harvesting and sale of timber shall be submitted to the Review 13 Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 14 for prior review. If it has been determined that the 22 Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services cannot continue to 23 contract with private provider(s) for residential juvenile services, 24 educational services, therapeutic services, and/or medical services and deems 25 it necessary to utilize Department staff to provide all or parts of the 26 required services above, the Department is authorized to seek the approval of 27 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and the Arkansas 28 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee to utilize the contingent 29 residential services positions contained in this Act and to make the 30 appropriate transfers from any line item authorized in the RESIDENTIAL 31 SERVICES appropriation of this Act to any line item authorized in the 32 OPERATIONS appropriation of this Act. 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contract with private provider(s), the Department is authorized to seek the
 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor and the
 Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee to make the
 appropriate transfers from any line item authorized in the OPERATIONS
 appropriation of this Act to any line item authorized in the RESIDENTIAL
 SERVICES appropriation of this Act.

EXTRA 12 HELP SALARIES - CONTINGENT RESIDENTIAL SERVICES POSITIONS. There is hereby 13 established for the Department of Human Services - Division of Youth Services 14 - Contingent Residential Services Positions, the following maximum number of 15 positions whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform 16 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code § 21-5-201 et seq.), or 17 its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Requests to use positions 18 will be based upon the non-contracted services for residential juvenile 19 services, educational services, therapeutic services, and/or medical 20 services. If at such time a category(s) of services are contracted with 21 private provider(s), identified positions associated with such service(s) 22 shall be returned to the contingency pool. In order to ensure required 23 staffing levels, Extra Help positions authorized herein are specifically 24 exempt from limitation of hours, either by Act or regulation. 25

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36 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

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1 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 3 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

10 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 12 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 13 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18

19 SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 20 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 21 22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 24 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm 25 26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 28 29 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019. 30 31 32 */s/Joint Budget Committee* 33 34
