The placement data shall also reflect the city and state of 22 employment; 23 (4) Such additional student data and operating cost as may be 24 necessary to enable the Legislative Council, the House Committee on Education, and the Senate Committee on Education to evaluate the courses of 25 26 instruction offered, the per student cost per classroom hour of instruction, 27 and the relative benefits of the instruction in placing the student in 28 gainful employment upon completion of the course of instruction. (c) The Legislative Council, the House Committee on Education, and the 29 30 Senate Committee on Education are authorized to promulgate standard and uniform forms and regulations to be followed by the various area vocational-31 technical schools in compiling and furnishing information required in this 32 33 section. 34
