20 SECTION 39. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY 22 FAIR GRANTS. The Rural Services Division of the Arkansas Economic Development 23 Commission shall develop the necessary rules and regulations for the 24 disbursement of matching fund grants to county fairs for the construction, 25 renovation and/or improvements to county fairgrounds. The grants shall be 26 matched on a 50/50 basis. The match may be cash or in-kind. No county fair 27 shall receive more than \$30,000 for the biennium.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018
29 <u>2019</u> through June 30, 2019 <u>2020</u>.

SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANT AWARD CRITERIA. The Rural Services Division of the Arkansas Economic Development Commission shall promulgate regulations establishing the criteria to be utilized in determining to whom grants will be made under this Act. Subject to the approval of the Governor, and approval by the Arkansas

Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee, the Rural Services

2 Division of the Arkansas Economic Development Commission shall distribute the 3 grants.

4 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 5 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 6 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 7 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 8 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 9 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 10 has determined that the Rural Services Division of the Arkansas Economic 11 Development Commission may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is 12 provided to the Rural Services Division of the Arkansas Economic Development 13 Commission authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is 14 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 15 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 16 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 17 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 18 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint 19 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 20 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018

SECTION 41. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 24 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 26 OF FUNDS. In the event that revenue is available for transfer to and in 27 support of the Arkansas Acceleration Fund Act, the Executive Director of the 28 Arkansas Economic Development Commission shall certify to the Chief Fiscal 29 Officer of the State the amount needed for transfer from either the Arkansas 30 Economic Development Commission Fund Account or the Miscellaneous Agencies 31 Fund Account to the Arkansas Acceleration Fund. Upon the approval of the 32 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the amount certified shall be transferred. 33 The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall initiate the necessary transfer 34 documents to reflect all such transfers upon the fiscal records of the State Auditor, the State Treasurer and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. 35 36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018

SECTION 42. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 5 FORWARD - MILITARY AFFAIRS GRANT PROGRAM. Any unexpended balance of funds 6 allocated for the Military Affairs Grant Program in the Arkansas Economic 7 Development Commission Fund Account which remain at the close of each state 8 fiscal year shall be carried forward to the next state fiscal year to be used 9 for the same intent and purposes as set forth in law. Any carry forward of 10 unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward 11 under the following conditions:

12 (1) Prior to June 30, 2019 2020 the Agency shall by written statement set
13 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
14 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

15 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall 16 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the 17 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting 18 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or 19 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name 20 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the 21 written request set forth in (1) above;

22 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written 23 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 24 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written 25 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for 26 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) 27 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents 28 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 29 Committee; and

30 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
31 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
32 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.

SECTION 43. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

1 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 2 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 3 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

10 SECTION 44. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 11 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 12 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 13 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 14 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 15 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 16 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 17 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 18

19 SECTION 45. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 20 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 21 22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of 23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 24 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm 25 26 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 27 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 28 29 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2019. 30 31 32 */s/Joint Budget Committee* 33 34
