- 20 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
- 21 has determined that the Rural Services Division of the Arkansas Economic
- 22 Development Commission may operate more efficiently if some flexibility is
- 23 provided to the Rural Services Division of the Arkansas Economic Development
- 24 Commission authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is
- 25 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
- 26 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 27 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
- 28 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this

- 32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018

- 35 SECTION 42. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER

- 1 OF FUNDS. In the event that revenue is available for transfer to and in
- 2 support of the Arkansas Acceleration Fund Act, the Executive Director of the
- 3 Arkansas Economic Development Commission shall certify to the Chief Fiscal
- 4 Officer of the State the amount needed for transfer from either the Arkansas
- 5 Economic Development Commission Fund Account or the Miscellaneous Agencies
- 6 Fund Account to the Arkansas Acceleration Fund. Upon the approval of the
- 7 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the amount certified shall be transferred.
- 8 The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall initiate the necessary transfer
- 9 documents to reflect all such transfers upon the fiscal records of the State
- 10 Auditor, the State Treasurer and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.
- 11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018
- 12 <u>2019</u> through June 30, 2019 <u>2020</u>.

- 14 SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
- 16 FORWARD MILITARY AFFAIRS GRANT PROGRAM. Any unexpended balance of funds
- 17 allocated for the Military Affairs Grant Program in the Arkansas Economic
- 18 Development Commission Fund Account which remain at the close of each state
- 19 fiscal year shall be carried forward to the next state fiscal year to be used
- 20 for the same intent and purposes as set forth in law. Any carry forward of
- 21 unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein, may be carried forward
- 22 under the following conditions:
- 23 (1) Prior to June 30, $\frac{2019}{2020}$ 2020 the Agency shall by written statement set
- 24 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
- 25 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- 26 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
- 27 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
- 28 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting
- 29 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
- 30 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name
- 31 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the
- 32 written request set forth in (1) above;
- 33 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
- 34 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
- 35 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
- 36 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for

- 1 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
- 2 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
- 3 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
- 4 Committee; and
- 5 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
- 6 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
- 7 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.
- 8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2018
- 9 2019 through June 30, 2019 2020.

11 SECTION 44. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds

12 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

14 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and

15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

21 SECTION 45. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

22 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

23 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for

which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

25 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget

26 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 30 <u>SECTION 46. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the
- 31 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
- 32 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
- 33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2019 is essential to the operation of
- 34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 35 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
- 36 <u>effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2019 could work irreparable harm</u>
