Prior to July 1 of each fiscal year, the Legislative 2 Council or the Joint Budget Committee shall review the Parks and Tourism Department's plan for the upcoming year of amounts to be disbursed for each 3 4 park or other entity from the funds appropriated for State Operations of this 5 Act. The request for review from the agency shall include amounts to be 6 disbursed for each entity for the upcoming fiscal year compared to the 7 current fiscal year's anticipated expenditures and the previous fiscal year's 8 actual expenditures with any additional detail as may be required by the 9 reviewing body. The rates of 24 pay may not exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification Act, or its 25 successor, for the appropriate classification. The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, 2018 2019 through June 30, 2019 2020. 26 27

SECTION 28. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 19, 28 29 Chapter 6, Subchapter 8 is amended to read as follows: 30 19-6-839. Arkansas Wine Grants Fund.

31 (a)(1) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a special revenue 32 fund to be known as the "Arkansas Wine Grants Fund". 33

(2) The Arkansas Wine Grants Fund shall consist of fees collected from 34 grocery store wine permits under § 3-5-1802 and shall be administered by the 35 36 Department of Finance and Administration.

(b) Fifty percent (50%) of fees that are deposited into the Arkansas Wine
Grants Fund under § 3-5-1802 shall be divided among the wineries seeking
grant payments under § 3-5-901 et seq., according to the same ratio as the
wine taxes paid in the previous calendar year by the grantee as determined by
the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, not to exceed the amount paid in by
each grantee.

7 (c) Fifty percent (50%) of fees that are deposited into the Arkansas Wine
8 Grants Fund under § 3-5-1802 shall be transferred to the Tourism Development
9 Trust Fund for the purpose of <u>land acquisition, construction, lease,</u>

Disbursement of funds 18 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 19 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 20 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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27 SECTION 30. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 28 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 29 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 30 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 31 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 32 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 33 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 34 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 35
