## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF CITY TREASURER IN A CITY OF THE SECOND CLASS AND AN INCORPORATED TOWN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF CITY TREASURER IN A CITY OF THE SECOND CLASS AND AN INCORPORATED TOWN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-44-109(a), concerning certain elected positions in a city of the second class, is amended to read as follows:
(a)(l)(A) At the time prescribed in this subtitle, the qualified voters of each city of the second class shall elect a city marshal, a city recorder, and a city treasurer.
(B) Each of these officers city marshal, city recorder, or city treasurer shall continue in office until his or her successor is elected and qualified.
(2) The city council may provide by ordinance for the appointment of the city treasurer.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-44-115 is amended to read as follows:
14-44-115. Election of recorder, treasurer, or recorder-treasurer.
(a) On the Tuesday following the first Monday in November, 1972, and every four (4) years thereafter, the qualified voters of cities of the second

class shall elect a recorder, a treasurer, or a recorder-treasurer, as the
case may be, for a term of four (4) years.
    (b) The city council may provide by ordinance for the appointment of
the treasurer.
    SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 14-45-108 is amended to read as follows:
    14-45-108. Election of recorder-treasurer.
    (a) The qualified voters of incorporated towns shall elect one (l)
recorder-treasurer on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November 1982
and every four (4) years thereafter.
    (b) The town council may provide by ordinance for the appointment of
the recorder-treasurer.
