18	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
19	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that delay in implementation of		
20	this act would cause disruption in the business market and that a need exists		
21	for consistency in the implementation of the Minimum Wage Act of the State of		
22	Arkansas, § 11-4-201 et seq. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist,		
23	and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public		
24	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
25	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
26	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
27	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
28	bill; or		
29	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
30	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
