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(a)(1) The Career Education and Workforce Development Board of
 <u>Corrections</u> shall locate facilities and operate vocational or technical
 education or training programs within the Riverside Vocational and Technical
 School.

5 (2)(A) The operation of the school is subject to such special 6 rules deemed appropriate for the operation of vocational or and technical 7 education or training programs at the correctional institutions under the 8 control of the Department of Correction and the Department of Community 9 Correction.

(B) The special rules required under subdivision (a)(2)(A)
 of this section shall be in accordance with agreements and rules mutually
 developed and agreed to by the Career Education and Workforce Development
 Board and the Board of Corrections.

(b)(1) The school shall be entitled to all funds, rights, and
privileges and shall be operated in the same manner as other area vocational
and technical schools are operated in this state.

17 (2) However, the school shall be operated in accordance with the 18 <u>special</u> rules for the operation of vocational or <u>and</u> technical education or 19 training programs at facilities of the Department of Correction and the 20 Department of Community Correction as provided in §§ 12-29-306 - 12-29-310. 21

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 12-29-310(a), concerning the cost of implementation and operation of Riverside Vocational and Technical School, is amended to read as follows:

25 The cost of implementing and operating the Riverside Vocational (a) 26 and Technical School at facilities of the Department of Correction and the 27 Department of Community Correction as authorized by this section and §§ 12-28 29-306 - 12-29-309 shall be borne by the state and shall be paid from funds 29 appropriated by the General Assembly to the school, the Department of Career 30 Education, and to the Department of Correction, and the Department of 31 Community Correction, together with any federal funds that may be available 32 for this purpose in the following manner:

(1) The cost of facilities and equipment in excess of the amount
of moneys provided by the school and the Department of Career Education shall
be borne by the Department of Correction and the Department of Community
Correction as approved by the Board of Corrections; and

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1	(2)(A) This section and §§ 12-29-306 — 12-29-309 contemplate		
2	that the Department of Correction and the Department of Community Correction		
3	will provide facilities for the vocational and technical education programs		
4	operated by the school.		
5	(B) However, nothing in this section and §§ $12-29-306$ –		
6	12-29-309 shall prohibit the Career Education and Workforce Development Board		
7	from providing <del>facilities</del> or sharing in the cost of facilities <del>and</del> <u>or</u> from		
8	providing or sharing in the cost of <del>repairing</del> repairs, maintenance, and		
9	upkeep of the buildings and facilities with the Department of Correction and		
10	the Department of Community Correction as funds are provided by the General		
11	Assembly, or are otherwise available for these purposes.		
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
